

How to get to Hamburg

Hamburg is easy to reach by plane, train as well as by car.

By airplane:

Between 6 a.m. and 11 p.m., commuter trains (“S-Bahn”) leave every 10 minutes from Hamburg Airport to the city center of Hamburg. It just takes 25 minutes to get to the main station in the inner city. There, you can easily change to another train that brings you to the University of Hamburg within 5 minutes – or to your hotel.

By train:

Hamburg Hauptbahnhof (main station) is a long distance railway station. Many trains also stop at Dammtor-Bahnhof which is very close to the Hamburg University. You can search for your best train connection to and from Hamburg here:

Inner city traffic:

By car:

Hamburg is also accessible by car via the motorways A1 (Bremen-Lübeck), A7 (North-South bypass), A23 (Hamburg-Nordfriesland) and A24 (Hamburg-Berlin). In rush hours, the inner city streets are relatively congested, so keep in mind that traveling might take longer than expected. The dynamic parking guidance system of Hamburg might help you to find a parking space. However, such space is rare nearby the University. You can find a public parking underneath the hotel “Grand Elysee” (Rothenbaumchaussee 10), directly opposite the main building of the university.

Congress venue

The congress venue, the main building of the University of Hamburg and its west wing, is located just opposite the train station 'Hamburg-Dammtor' (the ICE, regional- and suburban railway stop here) and close to the underground railway station 'Stephansplatz'.
